Enclosed is Delta Dental of Pennsylvania's Community Health Reinvestment (CHR) Activities proposal for the 2015-2016 fiscal year. The enclosed detailed list of proposed grantees includes clinic name, address and grant amount.

Delta Dental of Pennsylvania issues monies through the Delta Dental Community Care Foundation, a non-profit foundation whose mission is to increase access to dental care. Grants are awarded to non-profit community clinics that help support the "dental care safety net" for children and adults who might otherwise do without needed treatment because of low income and/or limited access to care.

The grants issued by the Foundation will not be used for advertising, public relations, sponsorships, bad debt, administrative costs associated with State health care programs, programs provided as an employee benefit, use of facilities for meetings held by community groups or expenses for in-service training, continuing education, orientation or mentoring of employees. Therefore, we believe that our expenditures meet the criteria included in the definition of CHR Activities and are compliant with Act 62 of 2008.
