

Pursuant to the requirements listed in Commonwealth Court Rule 3779, the following rules apply to all objections to a Notice of Determination filed with the Court. The rules are as follows;

Rule 3781(c)(4) Corporate representation. If the claimant is an entity other than a natural person, an attorney admitted to practice in Pennsylvania must enter an appearance for the claimant within sixty (60) days of the filing of the objection, or the Court may dismiss the objection.

Rule 3781(c)(5) Pro hac vice admission. If a claimant wishes to be represented by an attorney not admitted to practice in Pennsylvania, that attorney must be admitted to practice *pro hac vice*, in accordance with Pa. R.C.P. No. 1012.1, Pa. B.A.R. 301, and 204 Pa. Code § 81.505, within sixty (60) days of the filing of the objection, or the Court may dismiss the objection.
