### LIQUIDATOR'S APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL OF NOTICE OF FINAL ACCOUNTING, FINAL DISTRIBUTION AND DISCHARGE, AND FOR APPROVAL OF FINAL CLAIMS REPORT

Jessica K. Altman, Insurance Commissioner of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in her official capacity as Statutory Liquidator ("Liquidator") of Regis Insurance Company ("Regis"), by her undersigned attorney, pursuant to 40 P.S. § 221.46, 40 P.S. § 221.48, Pa. R.A.P. 3784(a) and 40 P.S. § 221.45, respectfully files this Application seeking approval of her Notice of: 1) her final accounting, final distribution and discharge; and 2) her final report and recommendations on claims as of August 31, 2018 ("Final Claims Report"),<sup>1</sup> to complete the liquidation of Regis, and thus represents:

1. By Order of this Court dated October 30, 2015, Regis was ordered liquidated, and the then Insurance Commissioner of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Teresa D. Miller and her successor in office, if any, was appointed Statutory Liquidator and directed to take possession

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup>The Liquidator typically files for approval of her final report and recommendations on claims separately, and prior to, seeking approval of notice of a final accounting, final distribution and discharge application. However, the Liquidator is combining in one application her request for approval of the final claims report with her application for approval of notice of her final accounting, final distribution and discharge due to the very limited amount of assets that are available to pay administrative expenses in the Regis estate.

of Regis's property and to liquidate its business and affairs. Jessica K. Altman is the successor to Ms. Miller and the current Insurance Commissioner, and thus is the current Liquidator of the Regis estate.

2. The Regis Special Purpose Statement of Assets and Liabilities and Deficit (unaudited) as of June 30, 2018, discloses assets of \$312,738. (See Regis's Special Purpose Statement of Assets and Liabilities and Deficit attached hereto as Exhibit A.)

3. As of June 30, 2018, the Liquidator has \$217,717 in unpaid administrative expenses. (See Exhibit "A".)

4. As of June 30, 2018, the guaranty associations ("GAs") have \$276,206 in unpaid administrative expenses. (See Exhibit "A".)

5. The total net assets available for distribution as of June 30, 2018, after a reserve of \$15,500 for future pre- and post-discharge administrative expenses of the Liquidator, are \$297,238. (See Exhibit A.)<sup>2</sup>

6. All claims have been evaluated and there are no unresolved objections to the amount allowed for any claim.

7. The total for class "a", "b" and "e" priority claims that has been approved and allowed is \$2,306,554. There are no "c", "d", "f", "g", "h" or "i" claims.

8. Attached hereto as Exhibit "B" is a list of all Regis claimants who had claims approved and the amount allowed for each claim. The Liquidator requests this Court's approval of the following distribution of the assets of Regis as follows:

- a. Priority class "a" claims will be paid at 70.5%. The Liquidator has already received \$120,344 in administrative expenses.
- b. Priority class "b" claims will not be paid.
- c. There are no priority class "c" claims.
- d. There are no priority class "d" claims.
- e. Priority class "e" claims will not be paid.
- f. There are no priority class "f" claims.
- g. There are no priority class "g" claims.
- h. There are no priority class "h" claims.
- i. There are no priority class "i" claims.

9. All class "b" claims have been paid in full by the Gas,<sup>3</sup> and there are no class "b" claims in excess of the GA statutory limits. Accordingly, all class "b" claimants have been made whole notwithstanding the very limited amount of assets in the Regis estate, other than the GAs, which will not receive any pro rata distribution from the estate with respect to the class "b" claims they have paid.

10. The Liquidator has collected all the assets deemed worthy of pursuit.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>3</sup>All the class "b" claims have been handled by the Pennsylvania Property and Casualty Insurance Guaranty Association ("PPCIGA"), except for one class "b" claim that was handled by the Alabama Insurance Guaranty Association ("AIGA"). There are no other GAs involved in the Regis liquidation.

11. Attached hereto as Exhibit "C" is a copy of the Notice of the filing of this Application for Approval of Notice of Final Accounting, Final Distribution and Discharge, and for Approval of Final Claims Report to be sent to all claimants in this matter upon this Court's approval of the form of Notice.

12. All claimants listed on Exhibit "B" will be served with the Notice, including the two GAs referenced in footnote 2 above, and provided 30 days from the date of the Notice to file objections, if any, to the Final Accounting, Final Distribution and Discharge or the Final Claims Report.

13. Once all objections to the Final Accounting, Final Distribution and Discharge or the Final Claims Report, if any, have been resolved, the Liquidator will file an application seeking this Court's approval of her Final Accounting, Final Distribution and Discharge and Final Claims Report, which will contain, and seek approval of, her recommendation regarding the disposition of records pursuant to 40 P.S. § 221.50. Should the Court approve that application, the Liquidator will file a final application following the completion of the final distribution of assets seeking discharge of the Liquidator in accordance with 40 P.S. § 221.48(a).

### FINAL CLAIMS REPORT

14. As mentioned above, the Liquidator also requests the Court's approval of the Final Claims Report pursuant to 40 P.S. § 221.45 and Pa. R.A.P. 3784(a).

15. The Liquidator's Final Claims Report is comprised of one part and is attached hereto as Exhibit D.<sup>4</sup> The claims are sorted alphabetically, within each class, by the claimant's

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>4</sup>These types of claims reports typically contain a second part which addresses claims that were determined and finalized because no exceptions were taken to a referee's recommended decision, a recommended decision was sustained by the Court or the parties agreed to a settlement and are referred to as "Resolved Claims". However, in the

last name or company name. The amount claimed by the claimant, *inter alia*, is also included in the Final Claims Report.<sup>5</sup>

16. Exhibit D addresses claims that were determined and finalized without objection, and for which the objection period expired on or before August 31, 2018. These claims are referred to as "Undisputed Claims". In this Final Claims Report, the Liquidator respectfully submits her recommendations for a total of 4 Undisputed Claims, with a total allowed amount of \$2,060,956.98, in accordance with Pa. R.A.P. 3784(a) and 40 P.S. § 221.45, for this Court's approval.<sup>6</sup>

17. In fulfilling her statutory requirements, the Liquidator carefully reviewed all documentation submitted by the claimants in support of the claims and independently determined the merit, classification and value of each claim, as required by 40 P.S. §§ 221.37, 221.38, 221.44, 221.45.

18. Given the discretion afforded the Liquidator pursuant to 40 P.S. § 221.45(a) to "comport, compromise, or in any other manner negotiate the amount for which claims will be recommended to the court," the Liquidator believes that the classification and amounts she has determined for the reported claims are appropriate, fair and equitable and consistent with the relevant provisions of Article V of the Insurance Department Act of 1921.<sup>7</sup> The Liquidator further

<sup>5</sup>If the claimant did not indicate a specific claim amount on the Proof of Claim, the claimed amount is noted as \$0.

Regis estate, no objections have been filed to the Liquidator's evaluations of the claims received, and thus there are no Resolved Claims to report.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>6</sup>The amount allowed for PPCIGA's class "a" claim is more than the amount claimed because the Liquidator allows a fee for ongoing claims administration for those claims open at the time of final settlement with a GA. The amount allowed for AIGA's class "a" claim is the same as the amount claimed because AIGA was not handling any open claims at the time of the final settlement of its claim. The amount allowed for PPCIGA's class "b" claim is more than the amount claimed because an amount was allowed to account for loss and expense reserves posted at the time of final settlement. The amount allowed for AIGA's class "b" claim is the same as the amount claimed because there were no outstanding loss and reserves posted at the time of final settlement.
