The Pennsylvania Insurance Department ("Department") has completed its review of the application referenced above, filed pursuant to 31 Pa. Code § 161.3a and dated June 26, 2019. Our review of the application has resulted in the following determinations:

- Notice of receipt of the filing was published in the Pennsylvania Bulletin with a 30-day comment period. No public comments were received during the comment period; and
- Pursuant to 31 Pa. Code § 161.3a(a)(1), CTR is domiciled and authorized to transact reinsurance in a qualified jurisdiction, Bermuda; and
- Pursuant to 31 Pa. Code § 161.3a(e)(2), the Department hereby renews CTR's designation as a certified reinsurer for the period January 1, 2020, through December 31, 2020; and
- Pursuant to 31 Pa. Code § 161.3a(a)(3)(ii) the rating hereby assigned to CTR is Secure – 2/10%.

This determination correspondence should be maintained in your records and will be required to be produced to other jurisdictions where CTR may request that the certified reinsurer designation be "passported" for 2020 based upon the Department's evaluation and determination and the review and concurrence of the NAIC Reinsurance Financial Analysis (E) Working Group ("ReFAWG").
