Dear Mr. Polcari:

The Pennsylvania Insurance Department ("Department") has completed the review of the Chubb Tempest Reinsurance Ltd. ("CTR") submissions for Reciprocal Jurisdiction Reinsurer ("Reciprocal Reinsurer") status pursuant to 40 P.S. §442.3.

The Department has determined that CTR has provided the appropriate and necessary information which meets or exceeds the filing requirements for Reciprocal Reinsurer status as of January 1, 2024. The Department hereby approves CTR in Pennsylvania as a Reciprocal Reinsurer, effective January 1, 2024, and continued through December 31, 2024.

CTR is approved to reinsure for those lines that it is authorized to engage in by its Supervisory Regulator. CTR's status as a Reciprocal Reinsurer is contingent upon maintaining full compliance with all provisions of 40 P.S. §442.3. If CTR ceases to meet the requirements, the Pennsylvania Insurance Commissioner may suspend or revoke its status as a Reciprocal Reinsurer.
