The Pennsylvania Insurance Department (“Department”) has completed its review of the MS Amlin AG (“the Company”) application, filed pursuant to 31 Pa. Code § 161.3 and received December 15, 2022.

The Company’s application request is determined pursuant to 31 Pa. Code § 161.3. The Company is domiciled and licensed in Switzerland and appears to comply with the Pennsylvania requirements for jurisdiction to be on the NAIC List of Reciprocal Jurisdictions.

Based upon the Department’s review of the application and in reliance upon the facts and representations contained herein, the Company meets the requirements of 31 Pa. Code § 161.3 and is hereby approved as a reciprocal jurisdiction reinsurer for property and casualty as the Company is authorized to engage in by its lead state regulator, Colorado Department of Regulatory Affairs.

The Company’s status as a reciprocal jurisdiction reinsurer is effective for the period January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023 and is contingent upon the Company maintaining full compliance with all the provisions contained in 31 Pa. Code § 161.3.
