### Application for Renewal of Designation as a Certified Reinsurer

Tokio Millenium Re AG, a reinsurer organized under Swiss law, has applied for renewal of its designation as a certified reinsurer in this Commonwealth. The application was received on March 20, 2018, and was made pursuant to the requirements set forth under section 319.1 of The Insurance Company Law of 1921 (40 P. S. §442.1(a)) and 31 Pa. Code § 161.3a (relating to requirements for certified reinsurers).

Persons who wish to comment on the application are invited to submit a written statement to the Insurance Department (Department) within 30 days from the date of this issue of the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*.
