RE: Certified Reinsurer Passporting Renewal Application for Underwriters at Lloyd's London

Dear Ms. Miesowitz:

The Pennsylvania Insurance Department ("Department") has completed its review of the application referenced above, filed pursuant to 31 Pa. Code § 161.3a, dated June 29, 2015, and supplemented with the October 5, 2015 correspondence issued by the New York State Department of Financial Services. Underwriters at Lloyd's London ("Lloyd's") is domiciled and licensed in the United Kingdom. Our review of the submission has resulted in the following determination:

- Pursuant to 31 Pa. Code § 161.3a(c), if an applicant for certification has been certified as a reinsurer in an NAIC accredited jurisdiction, the Commissioner has the discretion to defer to that jurisdiction's certification, and has the discretion to defer to the rating assigned by that jurisdiction.
- New York is an accredited jurisdiction and also serves as the lead U.S. insurance regulator of Lloyd's. The New York Department of Financial Services has approved Lloyd's as a certified reinsurer eligible for collateral reduction effective July 1, 2015 through December 31, 2016, with a rating as a Secure-3 reinsurer.
- Notice of receipt of the filing was published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* with a 30-day comment period. No public comments were received during the comment period.
- The Department hereby designates Lloyd's as a certified reinsurer eligible for collateral reduction effective July 1, 2015 through December 31, 2016, with a rating as a Secure-3 reinsurer.

- Lloyd's designation as a certified reinsurer and its rating are conditioned upon Lloyd's being domiciled and licensed in a qualified jurisdiction pursuant to 31 Pa. Code § 161.3a(a)(1). Lloyd's is domiciled and licensed in the United Kingdom and the United Kingdom is a qualified jurisdiction.
- Lloyd's status for collateral reduction is contingent upon Lloyd's maintaining full compliance with all of the provisions contained 31 Pa. Code § 161.3a, including but not limited to, submitting the annual renewal application for rating.
