The Pennsylvania Insurance Department ("Department") has engaged Boenning & Scattergood ("Boenning") as an independent consultant to assist in the Department's review of the proposals of Professional Casualty Association ("PCA") and Physicians' Insurance Program Exchange ("PIPE") to each effectuate a conversion (engagement letter attached).
