RE: 2021 Pennsylvania Private Passenger Automobile Data Call

The Pennsylvania Insurance Department (Department) is conducting its annual Private Passenger Automobile Data Call (previously referred to as the “Act 6 Data Call”). The purpose of this data call is to monitor the private passenger automobile insurance marketplace in Pennsylvania.

Insurance companies with Pennsylvania private passenger automobile direct written premium in 2021 are required to complete Parts 1 and 2. Data for more than one insurance company may not be combined into a single submission. This information is to be submitted to the Department **no later than October 17, 2022.**

Insurance companies with no Pennsylvania private passenger automobile direct written premium in 2021 are required to submit only Part 2. This is to be submitted to the Department **no later than October 17, 2022.**

Note: The 20 largest insurance companies in terms of Pennsylvania private passenger automobile direct written premium in 2021 as well as a few other selected insurers that write a high volume of minimum limits policies are also required to complete Parts 3 and 4. These companies are identified in the Instructions for Parts 3 and 4. Companies not identified in the Instructions for Parts 3 and 4 do not need to complete Parts 3 and 4. Parts 3 and 4 are to be submitted to the Department **no later than October 17, 2022.**

Consistent with previous data calls, the Department will consider the data submitted as proprietary and handle the data accordingly. Please see the instructions for additional information regarding the completion of the individual parts.

The 2021 data call letter, instructions, and templates are available on the Department’s website. From www.insurance.pa.gov, click on “Companies”, “Industry Activity” and “Data Calls” (under “PRODUCT AND RATE ACTIVITY”). The data call will also be announced in the Pennsylvania Bulletin.
