Dear Director Merritt:

I write today to urge you to add coverage of prostate cancer screenings to Pennsylvania's essential health benefits (EHB) package.

Under the Affordable Care Act, individual and small group (50 or fewer employees) health insurance policies must cover the ten categories of EHBs. Each state can select a benchmark plan to describe what specific benefits must be included in each EHB category.

Pennsylvania is behind the times. We have not updated our benchmark plan since 2017. The Insurance Department's reevaluation of Pennsylvania's EHB package shows the department's commitment to ensuring consumers get the care they need, when they need it.

Many Pennsylvanians need a prostate cancer screening. They can catch prostate cancer early, and that promotes health and saves lives. That's why I introduced House Bill 531. But the legislative process takes time. And the Insurance Department, by updating Pennsylvania's EHB package, can ensure coverage of this screening in individual and small group policies.

Thus, I urge you to ensure coverage of prostate cancer screenings, as contemplated in my House Bill 531, is included in any update to Pennsylvania's EHB package.
