ORDER


AND NOW, this 8th day of August, 2011, upon consideration of the Liquidator's Application for Discharge and Recommendation for Disposition of Records, the Application is GRANTED as follows:


1. Pursuant to Section 550 of The Insurance Department Act of 1921, Act of May 17, 1921, P.L. 789 (Act), added by the Act of December 14, 1977, P.L. 280, *as amended*, 40 P.S. § 221.50, the Liquidator is authorized to destroy the pre-liquidation records identified on the file inventory attached as Exhibit "E" to the Application on or before **October 7, 2011**;

2. The Pennsylvania Insurance Department shall retain for future reference all other records of American Integrity Insurance Company (AIIC), including records relating to the liquidation of the insurer, subject to any future court approval of a request to destroy records under Section 550 of the Act;

3. It appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that all assets justifying the expense of collection and distribution have been collected and distributed under the Act, this liquidation proceeding is TERMINATED. The effective date of the termination, however, is deferred until **October 7, 2011**.

4. Effective upon termination of this proceeding, Michael F. Consedine, in his official capacity as Insurance Commissioner of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, along with his predecessors and successors in office, is DISCHARGED from his duties as statutory liquidator of AIIC.
