**APPLICATION TO APPROVE THE FINAL DETERMINED AMOUNTS OF CLAIMS  
OF GUARANTY ASSOCIATIONS AFFECTED BY THE INSOLVENCY  
OF ROCKWOOD INSURANCE COMPANY**

Teresa D. Miller, in her official capacity as Insurance Commissioner of Pennsylvania, as Statutory Liquidator (the "Liquidator") of Rockwood Insurance Company (hereinafter "Rockwood"), by her undersigned attorney, respectfully applies to this Court for an Order approving the final determined amounts of claims of guaranty associations affected by the insolvency of Rockwood. In support of this Application, the Liquidator avers as follows:

**BACKGROUND AND FACTS**

1. By Order dated August 26, 1991, this Court found Rockwood to be insolvent and appointed the Insurance Commissioner, and her successors-in-office, as Liquidator of Rockwood.

2. Rockwood was a Pennsylvania domiciled property and casualty insurer that was licensed to write business in Alaska, Alabama, Arkansas, Arizona, Colorado, Delaware, Florida, Georgia, Iowa, Idaho, Indiana, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Maryland, Missouri, Mississippi, Montana, Nebraska, New Mexico, Nevada, Ohio, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, South Carolina, South Dakota, Tennessee, Texas, Utah, Virginia, Washington, and West Virginia.

3. Rockwood wrote various property and casualty lines of business, including workers' compensation coverage, which frequently creates long-term liability for the estate of an insolvent insurer. That has been the case in the Rockwood liquidation, where the remaining open claims are workers' compensation claims that are being handled by certain guaranty associations.

4. By Order dated August 10, 2010, this Court established a claims bar date of September 24, 2010 (the "Claims Bar Date"), by which date:

[a]ny and all claims against [Rockwood], against [the Liquidator], his agents and representatives, or in any way affecting or seeking to affect any assets of Rockwood, wherever or however such assets may be owned or held, directly or indirectly, must be filed with the Liquidator not later than the [Claims] Bar Date.

5. Like the approval of the Claims Bar Date, this Court's approval of the final determined amounts of the remaining claims of guaranty associations handling Rockwood claims will significantly assist the Liquidator's efforts to resolve the estate's long-term liability, and thus allow the Liquidator to take an important step toward finalizing the estate's affairs. As of December 31, 2015, 17 guaranty associations still had open claims, namely the Pennsylvania Workers Compensation Security Fund ("WCSF"), and guaranty associations from Alabama, Arkansas, Delaware, Florida, Georgia, Iowa, Louisiana, Maryland, Montana, Nebraska, New Mexico, Oklahoma, South Dakota, Tennessee, Texas, and Virginia which collectively reported 284 open claims with reserves totaling \$47,480,471. The reported claim number and reserve figures for each of these 17 guaranty associations are allocated as follows:

A chart setting forth the reported claims and reserves by guaranty association is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference.

6. In order to determine and finalize Rockwood's obligations to each relevant guaranty association, the Liquidator and each of the relevant guaranty associations have agreed to the final determined amounts of Rockwood's Class A (administrative expenses) and Class B (claim and loss adjustment expenses) obligations to each guaranty association. Those agreed final determined amounts are set forth on Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference.

7. On December 8, 2016, the Liquidator sent Notices of Determination to each of the relevant guaranty associations. Countersigned copies of those Notices of Determination affirming each guaranty association's agreement with the determined Class A and Class B amounts are attached hereto as Exhibit B and incorporated herein by reference.

#### **ARTICLE V AND RELIEF SOUGHT**

8. Article V of The Insurance Department Act of 1921, Act of May 17, 1921, P.L. 789, as amended, 40 P.S. §§ 221.1-221.63 (the "Act"), provides, *inter alia*, for the liquidation of insolvent insurers.

9. Section 501 of the Act, 40 P.S. § 221.1, provides that its provisions shall be liberally construed to protect the interests of insureds, creditors, and the public generally.

10. Section 523 of the Act grants broad powers to the Liquidator, and concludes in Section 523(23) by stating:

The enumeration, in this section, of the powers and authority of the Liquidator shall not be construed as a limitation upon him, nor shall it exclude in any manner his right to do such other acts not herein specifically enumerated, or otherwise provided for, as may be necessary or expedient for the accomplishment of or in aid of the purpose of liquidation.


11. In keeping with the powers and authority contained in Article V that allow the Liquidator to do such acts that may be necessary to aid the purpose of liquidation, the Liquidator

respectfully requests that the Court approve the final determined Class A and Class B amounts as agreed by each guaranty association and as set forth in Exhibit B hereto as Rockwood's full and final obligations to each relevant guaranty association, in order to allow the Liquidator to take an important and significant step toward finalizing the affairs of the Rockwood estate.

12. In seeking the relief sought in the instant Application, the Liquidator submits that this Application is consistent with the Liquidator's powers under the Act and is in the best "interests of insureds, creditors, and the public generally." See Section 501 of the Act, 40 P.S. § 221.1.

WHEREFORE, the Liquidator respectfully requests the entry of an Order, in the form attached hereto, approving the final determined amounts, as set forth in Exhibit A, and as agreed by each guaranty association, as set forth in Exhibit B, as Rockwood's full and final obligation to each relevant guaranty association.
