AND NOW, this 15th day of August, 2019, in light of this Court's contemporaneous order, which grants the petition for liquidation of Jessica K. Altman, Insurance Commissioner of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, orders Senior American Insurance Company (SAIC) to be liquidated, and declares SAIC to be insolvent as of September 3, 2019,<sup>2</sup> the Court hereby imposes a stay of all litigation pursuant to Section 526 of Article V of the Act, 40 P.S. § 221.26 (pertaining to actions by and against the Liquidator) beginning September 3, 2019 and ongoing.
