

EXHIBIT 1

EXHIBIT (To become part of Consent Order)

1. Underwriting Consultants Authority

- A To evaluate risks submitted on behalf of agents, administrators or insurance companies. To compute rates, benefits, claims experience exhibits and recommendations.
- B To accompany licensed agents at various meetings with the Insurance Co or licensed agents at various meetings with their clients to explain underwriting formulas, details of the rates and benefits quoted to said clients..
- C. Direct communication with underwriting departments of various underwriting companies for the purpose of discussing rates, benefit changes, or reinsurance.

2. Limits of Consultants Authority

Consultant shall have no authority as to the following;

- A Collect Premiums, monies or commission in any way.
- B Sell or solicit insurance, collect premiums, or applications from unlicensed entities, (Colleges, Schools, etc.)
- C Incur any indebtedness on behalf of agents or companies.
- D Print, publish, or disseminate any brochures or other documents.

3. Conduct of Consultant

Consultant agrees to conduct his activities on behalf of licensed agents or companies as authorized herein in a prudent and businesslike manner in accord with the rules and regulations of the Pa Insurance Dept., and any other states that may be applicable

4. Compensation

Consultant shall receive an underwriting fee. This fee will depend on the amount of work involved, the complexity of the case to be evaluated, and the time it takes for the consultant to complete.
